Parity of zero This can be easily verified based on the definition of "even": zero is an integer multiple of 2, specifically 0×2 . As a result, zero shares all the properties that characterize even numbers: for example, 0 is neighbored on both sides by odd numbers, any decimal integer has the same parity as its last digit—so, since 10 is even, 0 will be even, and if y is even then $y + x$ has the same parity as x —indeed, $0 + x$ and x always have the same parity.
