While the movement initially grew out of Christian ideals, not all modern Quakers identify as Christian. In The Religious Society of Friends began as a proto-evangelical Christian movement in England in the mid-17th century in Ulverston. Alice and Thomas Curwen, who had been busy in Rhode Island and New Jersey, were imprisoned in Boston under Massachusetts law and publicly flogged. The movement in its early days faced strong opposition and persecution, but it continued to expand across the British Isles, the Americas and Africa c23f633265
