These areas can be spared. Per the name, FSHD tends to sequentially weaken the muscles of the face, those that position the scapula, and those overlying the humerus bone of the upper arm. The two sides of the body are often affected unequally. Weakness typically manifests at ages 15–30 years. Abnormally positioned, termed 'winged', scapulas are common, as is the inability to lift the foot, known as foot drop 2190c221b2
