Soil consolidation This happens because soil is a three-phase material. The "over-consolidation ratio" (OCR) is defined as the highest stress experienced divided by the current stress Soil consolidation refers to the mechanical process by which soil changes volume gradually in response to a change in pressure. The theoretical framework of consolidation is therefore. The first phase consists of soil grains, and a combination of void (air) or other fluid (typically groundwater) comprise the second and third phases. When soil saturated with water is subjected to an increase in pressure, the high volumetric

stiffness of water compared to the soil matrix means that the water initially absorbs all the change in pressure without changing volume, creating excess pore water pressure. As water diffuses away from regions of high pressure due to seepage, the soil matrix gradually takes up the pressure change and shrinks in volume. is termed the 'preconsolidation stress'
