Rollback (data management) scheduled by dba. SQL refers to Structured Query Language, a kind of language used to access, update and manipulate database. Rollbacks are important for database integrity, because they mean that the database can be restored to a clean copy even after erroneous operations are performed. They are crucial for recovering from database server crashes; by rolling back any transaction which was active at the time of the crash, the database is restored to a consistent state.
