In 1994, Niren Deka et al.
reported that novel viral
particles had been discovered in
the stool of post-transfusion,
non-hepatitis A, non-hepatitis B,
non-hepatitis C, non-hepatitis E
patients. Injection of these
particles into the bloodstream of
Indian rhesus monkeys caused
hepatitis, and the virus was
named hepatitis F or Toga virus.
Further investigations failed to
confirm the existence of the
virus, and it was delisted as a
cause for infectious hepatitis.

bases from guanine to adenine
at base position 1896 (G1896A),
and from cytosine to thymine at
