Wicked problem Because of complex interdependencies, the effort to solve one aspect of a wicked problem may reveal or create other problems. Wicked problems have no given alternative solutions. Every solution to a wicked problem is a "one shot operation". Another definition is "a problem whose social complexity means that it has no determinable stopping point". Due to their complexity, wicked problems are often characterized by organized irresponsibility. Classic examples of wicked problems include In planning and policy, a wicked problem is a problem that is difficult or impossible to solve because of incomplete, contradictory, and changing requirements that are often difficult to recognize. It refers to an idea or problem that cannot be fixed, where there is no single solution to the problem; "wicked" does not indicate evil, but rather resistance to resolution c16c572f8e

Circular economy For example, in China A circular economy (CE), also referred to as circularity, is a model of resource production and consumption in any economy that involves sharing, leasing, reusing, repairing, refurbishing, and recycling existing materials and products for as long as possible. The main three principles required for the transformation to a circular economy are: designing out waste and pollution, keeping products and materials in use, and regenerating natural systems. The concept aims to tackle global challenges such as climate change, biodiversity loss, waste, and pollution by emphasizing the design-based implementation of the three base principles of the model.
