His reputation is controversial among scholars because he often repeats information from his sources without critically evaluating it. Due to the loss of so many of the primary sources on which Diogenes relied, his work has become the foremost surviving source on the Diogenes Laërtius (dy-OJ-in-eez lay-UR-shee-əs; Ancient Greek: Διογένης Λαέρτιος, Laertios; fl. the primary sources.
