For example, teachers and parents Positive behavior support (PBS) uses tools from applied behaviour analysis and values of normalisation and social role valorisation theory to improve quality of life, in schools and individuals with learning/intellectual disabilities. PBS uses functional analysis to understand what maintains an individual's challenging behavior and how to support the individual to get these needs met in more appropriate way, instead of using 'challenging behaviours'. Positive behavior support is increasingly being recognized as a strategy that is feasible, desirable, and effective c1a6e463b1

Rather than pushing students to achieve at a set grade level, seen through the emphasis of standardized testing, this approach attempts to customize learning goals to individual students' levels. It is a reaction against past practices that tended to focus on mental illness and emphasized maladaptive behavior and negative thinking.
