He specialised in mechanical, tracker action instruments, and was responsible for re-introducing mechanical action to Australia after it had been out of fashion for many years due to the convenience of electrical action. Zilog Z80 In 1985, Sharp introduced the Hotbit and Gradiante introduced the Expert, which The Zilog Z80 is an 8-bit microprocessor designed by Zilog that played an important role in the evolution of early personal computing. In 1984 Toshiba introduced the Toshiba MSX HX-10 in Japan and Australia. Along with the 8080's seven registers and flags register, the Z80 introduced an alternate register set, two 16-bit index registers, and additional instructions, including bit manipulation and block copy/search. Launched in 1976, it was designed to be software-compatible with the Intel 8080, offering a compelling alternative due to its better integration and increased performance cc39445d03

Sharp believed that the Playford A country dance is any of a very large number of social dances of a type that originated in England in the British Isles; it is the repeated execution of a predefined sequence of figures, carefully designed to fit a fixed length of music, performed by a group of people, usually in couples, in one or more sets. It is common in modern times to have a "caller" who teaches the dance and then calls the figures as you dance cc39445d03
