In response to a message it receives, an actor can: make local decisions, create more actors, send more messages, and determine how to respond to the next message received. TOCTOU race conditions are common in Unix between operations on the file system, but can occur in other contexts, including local sockets and improper use of database transactions. In the early 1990s, the mail utility of BSD 4.3 UNIX had an exploitable race condition for temporary files because it used the mktemp() function. aba2f8ee69
