He enrolled in Harvard in 1924, but eventually Damodar Dharmananda Kosambi (31 July 1907 - 29 June 1966) was an Indian polymath with interests in mathematics, statistics, philology, history, and genetics. Damodar Kosambi emulated him by developing a keen interest in his country's ancient history. He was also a Marxist historian specialising in ancient India. necessarily passing an entrance examination essential at the time to gain admission to Harvard University. He contributed to genetics by introducing the Kosambi map function. In statistics, he was the first person to develop orthogonal infinite series expressions for stochastic processes via the Kosambi-Karhunen-Loève theorem.
