Developmental psychologists aim to explain how thinking, feeling, and behaviors change throughout life. understand how life stage transitions and biological factors influence human behavior and development. This field examines change across three major dimensions, which are physical development, cognitive development, and social emotional development. Originally concerned with infants and children, the field has expanded to include adolescence, adult development, aging, and the entire lifespan. Within these three dimensions are a broad range of topics including motor skills, executive functions, moral understanding, language acquisition, social change, personality, emotional development, self-concept, and identity formation 887b137344
