**Titration** The titrant reacts with a solution of analyte (which may also be termed the titrand) to determine the analyte's concentration. A reagent, termed the titrant or titrator, is prepared as a standard solution of known concentration and volume. When one or more electrochemical cells are connected in parallel or series they make a battery. Primary battery consists of single-use galvanic cells. Rechargeable batteries are built from secondary cells that use reversible reactions and can operate as galvanic cells (while providing energy) or electrolytic cells (while charging).
