Egyptian Arabic *gá:wib/yigá:wib* "answer" from G-W-B). It is part of the Afro-Asiatic language family, and originated in the Nile Delta in Lower Egypt. These factors help make it the most widely spoken and by far the most widely studied variety of Arabic. The estimated 111 million Egyptians speak a continuum of dialects, among which Cairene is the most prominent. Like all verbs whose stem begins with a single Egyptian Arabic, locally known as Colloquial Egyptian, or simply as Masri, is the most widely spoken vernacular Arabic variety in Egypt. Example: *gá:b/yigí:b* "bring" This verb works much like *dárris/yidárris* "teach". It is also understood across most of the Arabic-speaking countries due to broad Egyptian influence in the region, including through Egyptian cinema and Egyptian music
