The first single from the new album, called "Chances", was released on July 21, 2009, as a digital download. It also debuted on the Billboard Hot 100 chart at number 83 and at number 12 on the Billboard Adult Contemporary chart on the week ending October 31, 2009. "Chances" can also be heard in the end credits of the 2009 film, *The Blind Side*. It can also be heard in the first promotional commercial video of *Idol* in season 10. The term refers to the process of making very quick inferences about the state, characteristics or details of an individual or situation with minimal amounts of information. Thin-slicing is a term used in psychology and philosophy to describe the ability to find patterns in events based only on "thin slices", or narrow windows Thin-slicing is a term used in psychology and philosophy to describe the ability to find patterns in events based only on "thin slices", or narrow windows, of experience. Judgments based on thin-slicing can be as accurate, or even more so, than judgments based on much more information
