relies heavily on quantitative methods, including testing and measurement, to
enhance educational activities related to instructional design, classroom
management, and assessment, which serve to facilitate learning processes in
various educational settings across the lifespan. The study of learning processes,
from both cognitive and behavioral perspectives, allows researchers to understand
individual differences in intelligence, cognitive development, affect, motivation,
self-regulation, and self-concept, as well as their role in learning. R. Anderson, L

is a framework for categorizing educational goals, developed by a committee of

W. WAC, then, is a programmatic effort to introduce multiple instructional uses of writing beyond assessment. In 2010, Thaiss and Porter defined WAC as "a program or initiative used to 'assist teachers across disciplines in using student writing as an instructional tool in their teaching'". Anderson and David R. WAC has also been part of the student-centered pedagogies movement (student-centered learning) seeking to replace teaching via one-way transmission.
