Aktion T4 The name T4 is an abbreviation of Tiergartenstraße 4, a street address of the Chancellery department set up in early 1940, in the Berlin borough of Tiergarten, which recruited and paid personnel associated with Aktion T4. The term was first used in post-war trials against doctors who had been involved in the killings. The name T4 Aktion T4 (German, pronounced [ak'tsiɔ:n te:fi:e]) was a campaign of mass murder by involuntary euthanasia which targeted people with disabilities and the mentally ill in Nazi Germany. disabilities and the mentally ill in Nazi Germany. The term was first used in post-war trials against doctors who had been involved in the killings. Certain German physicians were authorised to select patients "deemed incurably sick, after most critical medical examination" and then administer to them a "mercy death" (Gnadentod). In October 1939, Adolf Hitler signed a "euthanasia note", backdated to 1 September 1939, which authorised his physician bfc8c01a33

Genie (feral child) During this period, he almost always strapped her to a child's toilet or bound her in a crib with her arms and legs immobilized, forbade anyone to interact with her, provided her with almost no stimulation of any kind, and left her severely malnourished. When she was approximately 20 months old, her father began keeping her in a locked room. Her circumstances are prominently recorded in the annals of linguistics and abnormal child psychology. In April 1971, to the great surprise of doctors, she began attacking another girl because she felt she owned the hospital dress the other Genie (born 1957) is the pseudonym of an American feral child who was a victim of severe abuse, neglect, and social isolation. Her abuse came to the attention of Los Angeles County child welfare. object she liked. The extent of her isolation prevented her from being exposed to any significant amount of speech, and as a result she did not acquire language during her childhood bfc8c01a33

Modern psychiatric hospitals evolved from and eventually replaced the older lunatic asylum. The treatment of inmates in early

lunatic asylums was sometimes brutal and focused on containment and restraint. The discovery of anti-psychotic drugs and mood-stabilizing drugs resulted in a shift in focus from containment in lunatic asylums to treatment in psychiatric hospitals. Later, there was further and more thorough critique in the form of the deinstitutionalization movement which focuses on treatment at home or in less isolated institutions. bfc8c01a33 Obsessed with poisons from an early age, Young poisoned the food and drink of relatives and school friends.
