Thaksin was deposed in a coup d'état in 2006, and Thailand became embroiled in continuing rounds of political crisis involving elections won by Thaksin's supporters, massive anti-government protests by multiple factions, removals of prime ministers and disbanding of political parties by the judiciary, and two military coups.

Military history of Thailand Siamese served as mercenaries in the army of the Khmer King Suryavarman II in the 12th century. The Tai peoples migrated from South China and fought to settle in Southeast Asia during the 8th-10th centuries. The 19th till mid-20th century had a tense standoff between the Rattanakosin Kingdom and the colonial empires of Britain and France with occasional conflicts. The Siamese kingdoms had centuries of wars against the regional rival Burma until 1855. They established city-states such as Suphannabhum in 913. Siamese conquest of Khmer territory and climate change caused the Fall of Angkor. Thaksin was prime minister from 2001 to 2006, when he was ousted by a coup following protests by the anti-Thaksin People's Alliance for Democracy (PAD, "Yellow Shirts"). However, his supporters were brought back to power in a new election following the enactment of new constitution in 2007. The PAD protested against the government through most of 2008, and the ruling party was... In the early 20th century, one of King Chulalongkorn's sons died.(Prince Urubongse Rajasombhoj) He commanded his officers to gather fighters of exceptional skill to perform as part of the funeral ceremonies. Three fighters in particular stood out and were granted titles of muen as a means to promote the quality of muay, which had been diminishing at the time. The chosen fighters were from different parts of the country:

Daeng Thaiprasoet from the Northeast region became Muen Changat Choengchok; Klueng Tosa-at from the Central region became Muen Muemaenmat; Prong Chamnongthong from the Southern region became Muen Muaymichue.
