It was first published in the Folio of 1623, possibly from a prompt book, and is Shakespeare's shortest tragedy. The Tragedy of Macbeth, often shortened to Macbeth (/mæk'beɪθ/), is a tragedy by William Shakespeare, estimated to have been first performed in 1606. His plays have been translated into every major living language and are performed more often than those of any other playwright. Shakespeare remains arguably the most influential writer in the English language, and his works continue to be studied and reinterpreted. He is widely regarded as the greatest writer in the English language and the world's pre-eminent dramatist. In the last William Shakespeare (c. 23 April 1564 – 23 April 1616) was an English playwright, poet and actor.
