Yet, only 10% of children with cancer live in high-income countries where proper treatment and care are available. The majority of children with cancer are in low- and middle-income countries, where it is responsible for 94% of deaths among those under 15 years old. For this reason, in low and middle-income countries, childhood cancer is often ignored in control planning, contributing to the burden of missed opportunities for its diagnoses and management.
