Distributed practice Distributed practice (also known as spaced repetition, the spacing effect, or spaced practice) is a learning strategy, where practice is broken up into Distributed practice (also known as spaced repetition, the spacing effect, or spaced practice) is a learning strategy, where practice is broken up into a number of short sessions over a longer period of time. For example, when studying for an exam, dispersing your studying more frequently over a larger period of time will result in more effective learning than intense study the night before. The opposite, massed practice, consists of fewer, longer training sessions and is generally a less effective method of learning. Humans and other animals learn items in a list more effectively when they are studied in several sessions spread out over a long period of time, rather than studied repeatedly in a short period of time, a phenomenon called the spacing effect b4b9034d32

Answer set programming The computational process employed in the design of many answer set solvers is an enhancement of the DPLL algorithm and, in principle, it always terminates (unlike Prolog query evaluation, which may lead to an infinite loop). In ASP, search problems are reduced to computing stable models, and answer set solvers—programs for generating stable models—are used to perform search. It is based on the stable model (answer set) semantics of logic programming. In 1999, the term “answer set Answer set programming (ASP) is a form of declarative programming oriented towards difficult (primarily NP-hard) search problems. In 1998 Soenink and Niemelä applied what is now known as answer set programming to the problem of product configuration b4b9034d32
