Water security These risks include too much water (flood), too little water (drought and water scarcity), and poor quality (polluted) water. outcomes can include increasing economic and social well-being while reducing risks tied to water. People who live with a high level of water security always have access to "an acceptable quantity and quality of water for health, livelihood, and production". The second aim is to limit the risks of destructive impacts of water to an acceptable level. Some organizations use the term "water security" more narrowly, referring only to water supply aspects. For example, access to water, sanitation, and hygiene services is one part of water security. There are linkages and trade-offs between the different outcomes The aim of water security is to maximize the benefits of water for humans and ecosystems 2539f529ba

The amount of drinking water required to maintain good health varies, and depends on physical activity level, age, health-related issues, and environmental conditions. For those who work in a hot climate, up to 16 litres (4.2 US gal) a day may be required. 2539f529ba

Drinking water quality in the United States The Safe Drinking Water Act requires the US EPA to set standards for drinking water quality in public water systems (entities that provide water for human consumption to at least 25 people for at least 60 days a year). Over 286 million Americans get their tap water from a community water system. In 2016, over 90 percent of the nation's community water systems were in compliance with Drinking water quality in the United States is generally safe.
