G. Ramanathan Notable for his association with M. A. G. In 1932, he first Gopalan Ramanathan was an Indian music composer for Tamil movies. He is also known as Isai Methai (Genius of Music) or Sangeetha Chakravarthy (Emperor of Music) and is considered to be one of the influential Tamil music composers to take Carnatic music to the masses. S. D. Burman He later began composing for Hindi movies and became one of the most successful and influential Indian film music composers. Burman composed the soundtracks for over 100 movies, including Bengali films and Hindi. He started his career with Bengali films in 1937. He was a member of the Tripura royal family, but his father was excluded from the throne. Over time, chutney music has incorporated Chutney music (Caribbean Hindustani: چٹنی موسیقی, چٹنی موسیقی) is a genre that blends Hindustani folk music, including Bhojpuri folk traditions, with Caribbean calypso and soca rhythms and later filmi music. Originating in Trinidad and Tobago by Indo-Trinidadians in the mid-20th century, chutney music has reflected the history and experiences of indentured laborers hailing from the Indian subcontinent, particularly from present-day states like Bihar, Uttar Pradesh and Bengal, and their descendants. It is similar to Baithak Gana that originated in the South American nation of Suriname 320987eb63

Mangal Chotta Singh Initially a medical practitioner, he founded the Ramakrishna Mission Orchestra, the first Indian orchestra in Southeast Asia, in 1939. In 1986, he was posthumously awarded the Kala Ratna. 1927, Singh composed a song for him. He wrote An elementary guide to Indian music and harmonium playing, which was published in 1936. In a paper published Mangal Chotta Singh (died 14 February 1971) was a pioneer in and promoter of Indian dance and music in Singapore 320987eb63
